

MULTIVIEW BLOCKS

Civil 3D has some excellent tools for bringing some realism to our designs, not only can we assign visual styles to our surfaces, we can also include blocks that when viewed in different perspectives can bring our designs to life.

The ability to represent our design to a client in a photorealistic manner can't be underestimated.



The software has a built-in library of Multiview blocks with enough content to be able to set up our design to a good level of detail.

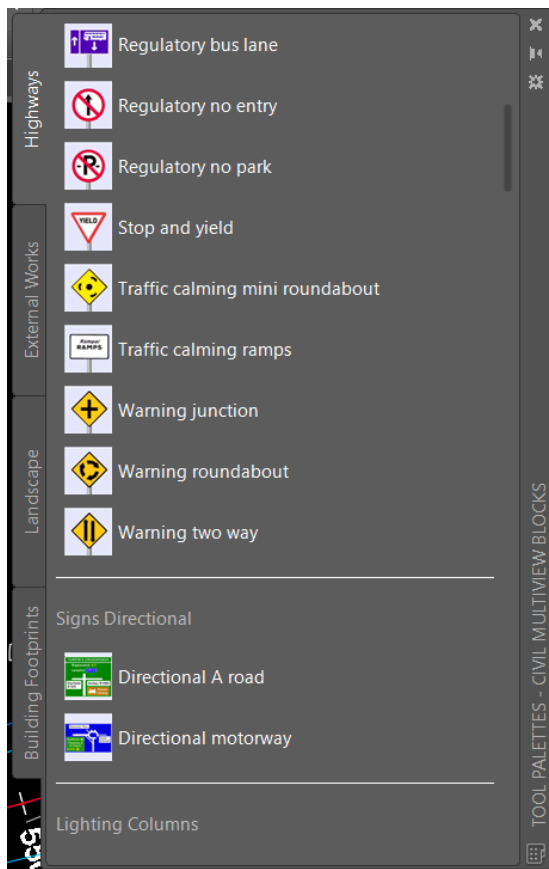
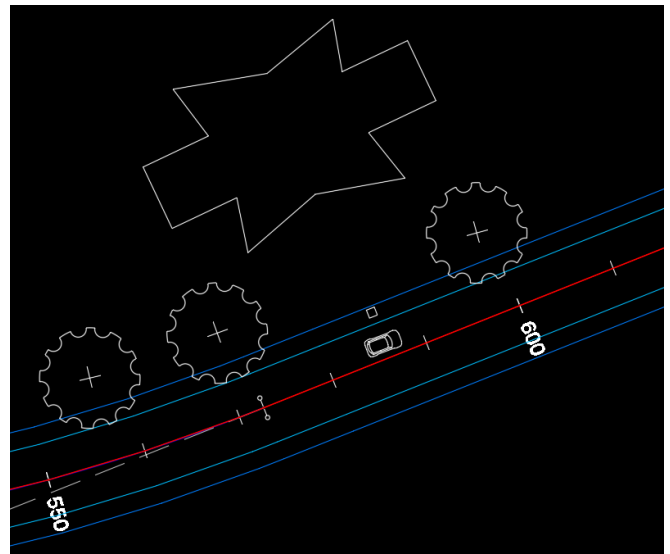
The options include:

- Highway signage
- Vehicle libraries
- External works including bollards, construction equipment, railings and people
- Landscaping including trees and hedgerow
- Buildings in a range of styles



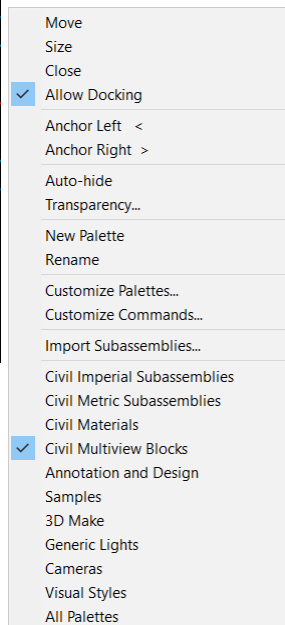
When viewed in plan, the blocks take on another style in line with what we would expect to see on our 2D deliverables.

Being able to use these blocks allows us to quickly develop projects using a range of viewing styles to suit the required deliverable.



The Multiview blocks are available through our Tool Palettes by right clicking on the palette and selecting Civil Multiview Blocks.

The main thing to remember is to bring these blocks to the surface so they are visible.
