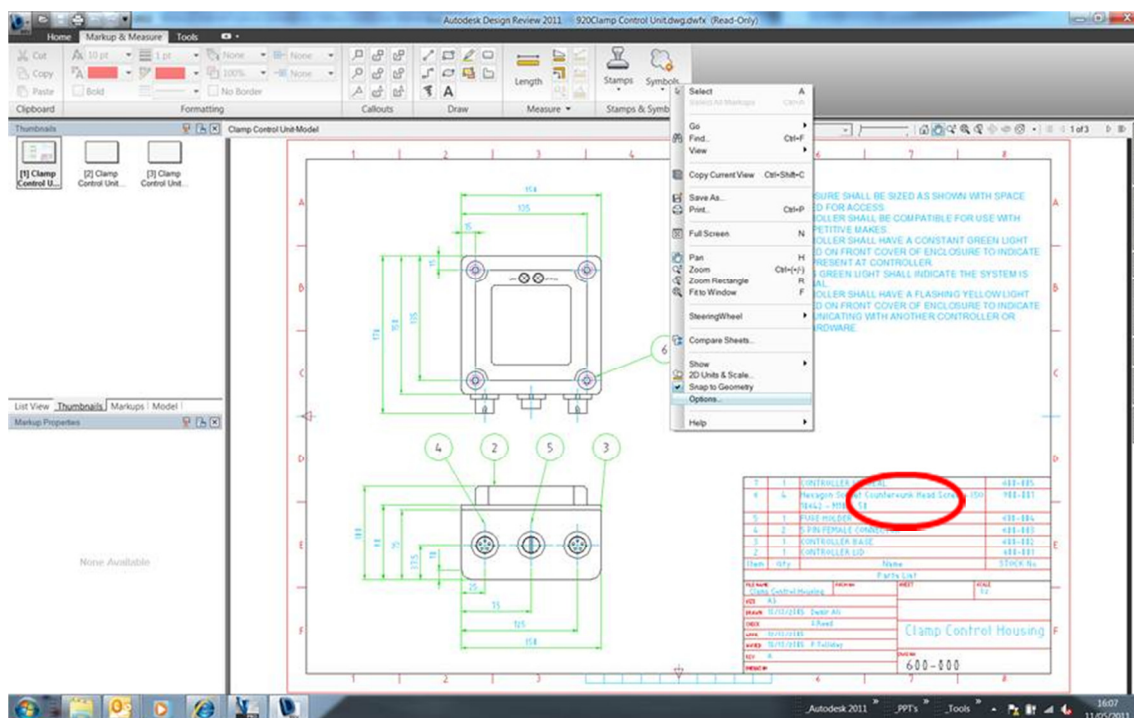


# The Autodesk Vault – Changing the Background colour of DWG's in Vault

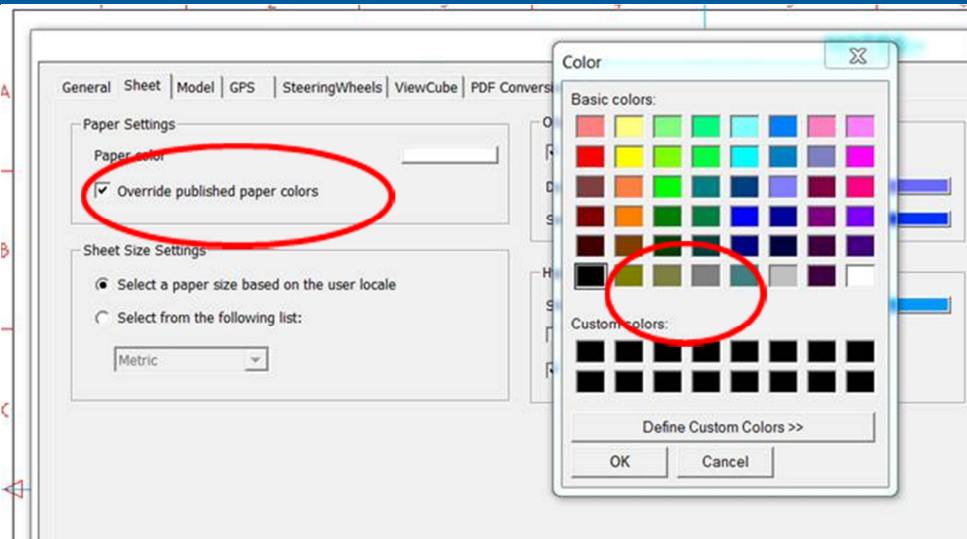
Some DWG's created in AutoCAD's Model space, are best viewed on a black background, often Vault displays this as white, this guide shows how to change the colour of Vault's background MS2011061

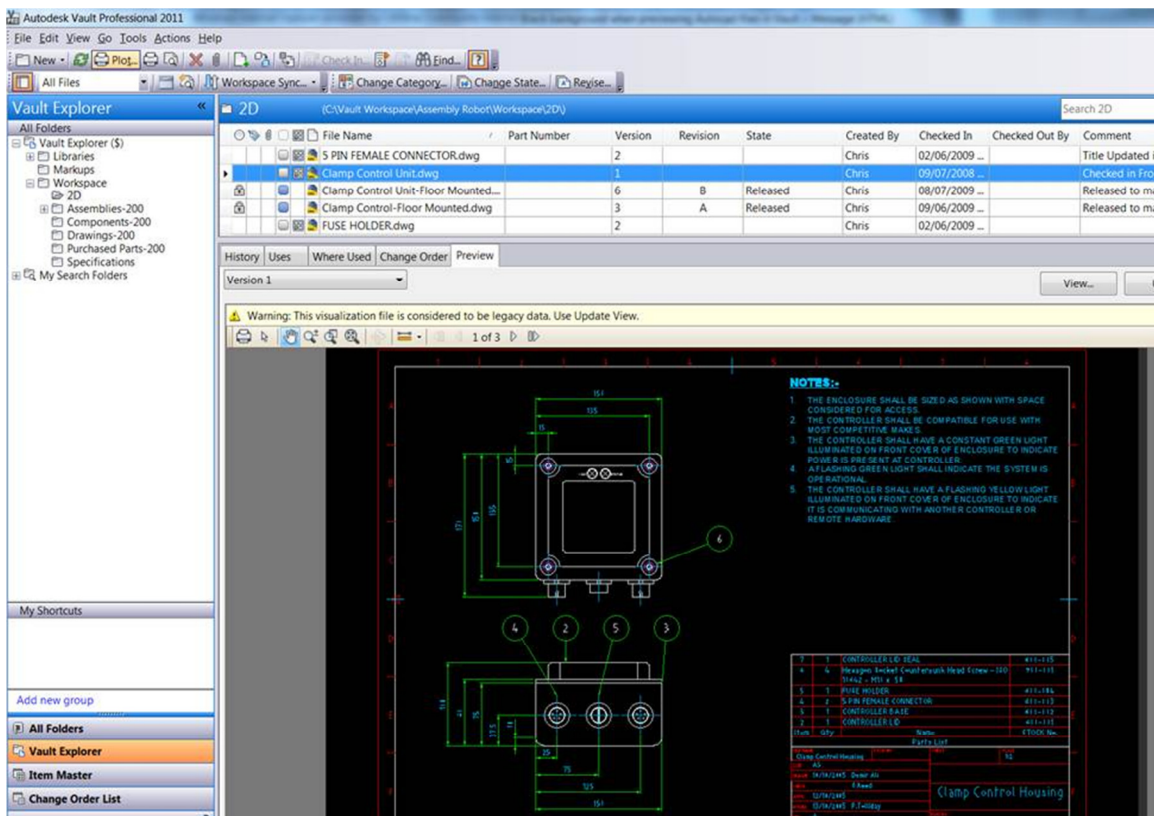
1. Open Vault Explorer and view a suitable dwg file (try it on one of your standard AutoCAD files that's in the Vault).
2. Right-click in the viewing area and select 'Open in Autodesk Design Review'. This will open the file in a separate window, but you are only doing this to change a setting.
3. Right-click in the drawing area in Design Review and select 'Options'.



4. On the Sheet tab, select 'Override published paper colours', press the white colour panel, then select black from the basic selection of colours.



5. Select OK (the background will be black in Design Review), then close Design Review. (Note, don't be disappointed at this stage that the background is still white in Vault).
6. Close Vault Explorer.
7. Re-start Vault Explorer ... and hey-presto it's black!
