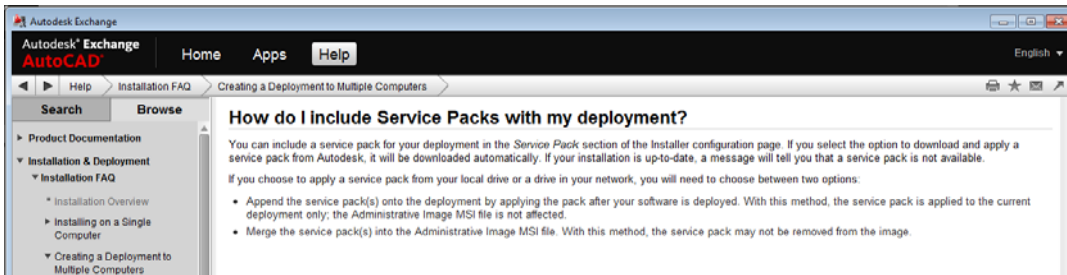
## Select Deployment option
