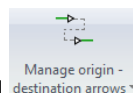


## elecworks™ Tips & Tricks

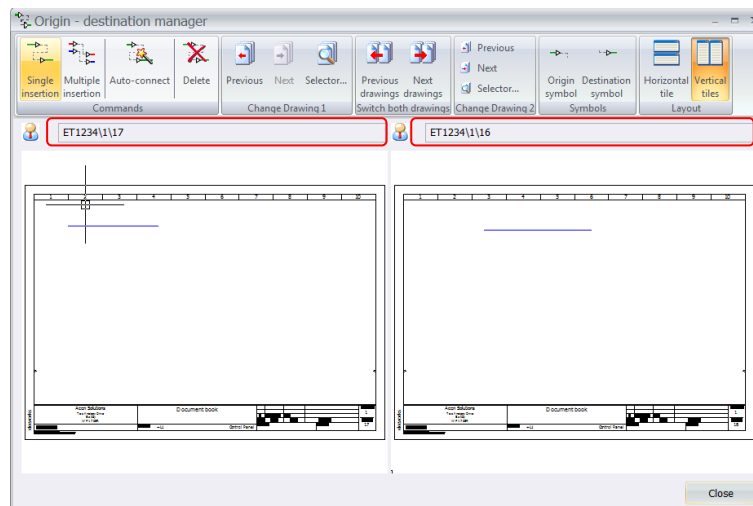
### Insertion of Origin – Destination Equipotential Arrows

elecworks™ has the ability to link one wire to another without the requirement of a wire number being placed using

the *Manage Origin – Destination arrows* command



You do not have to go in the norm of top to bottom, left to right or left to right, top to bottom. If you place the first arrow (origin) to be linked on page 3 and the second arrow (destination) on page 2 of a set of schematics, elecworks will connect the wire from page 3 to page 2.



This can be done by either of the following methods:

1. Simply ensure the *Change Drawing 1* is set at the source end of the wire and that *Change Drawing 2* is set at the destination end of the wire
2. When inserting arrows, you can pick the source as being on the “higher” schematic page first and then the destination on the “lower” schematic page

N.B. Wire numbering is not affected by the above

If you have the same wire number (manually edited) on both the source and destination

wires, you can use the command
