



# Find and Replace Attribute Information

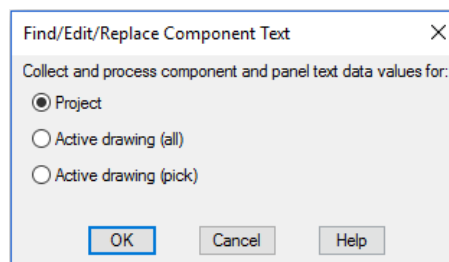
## AutoCAD Electrical 2017

The command searches for text inside attributes and replaces them with an alternative value.

You can select single or multiple symbols to be included in your search.

Select the *Schematic* ribbon tab > *Edit Components* panel >  *Retag Components* ▾ drop-down >  *Find/Edit/Replace Component Text*

You can find and replace text on the entire project, active drawing or selected parts of an active drawing




The example below shows the function across the entire project. Some options will be different if the current active drawing options are selected.



You can search on the *Tag, Manufacturer, Catalogue, Installation, Location, Assembly Code, Group, Mount* and *Description* lines.

If you tick the  *Find* check box, the associated  option will appear. You can select multiple  *Find* options. As an example:





Either type the attribute value in or select the value from a  of existing text values.

Select the  *Replace* check box for the selected attribute and type a new text string in the edit box or select the value from a  of existing text values.

You can search for the exact text string  *All* or a substring within the attribute text value  *Part*.

Select  to begin the find and replace operation. Each found match is displayed in a separate dialog box. You can edit, replace, skip to the next, or replace all of the found values.

**For terminal text**, select the *Schematic* ribbon tab > *Edit Components* panel >  *Retag Components*  
 ▼ drop-down >  *Find/Replace Terminal Text*
